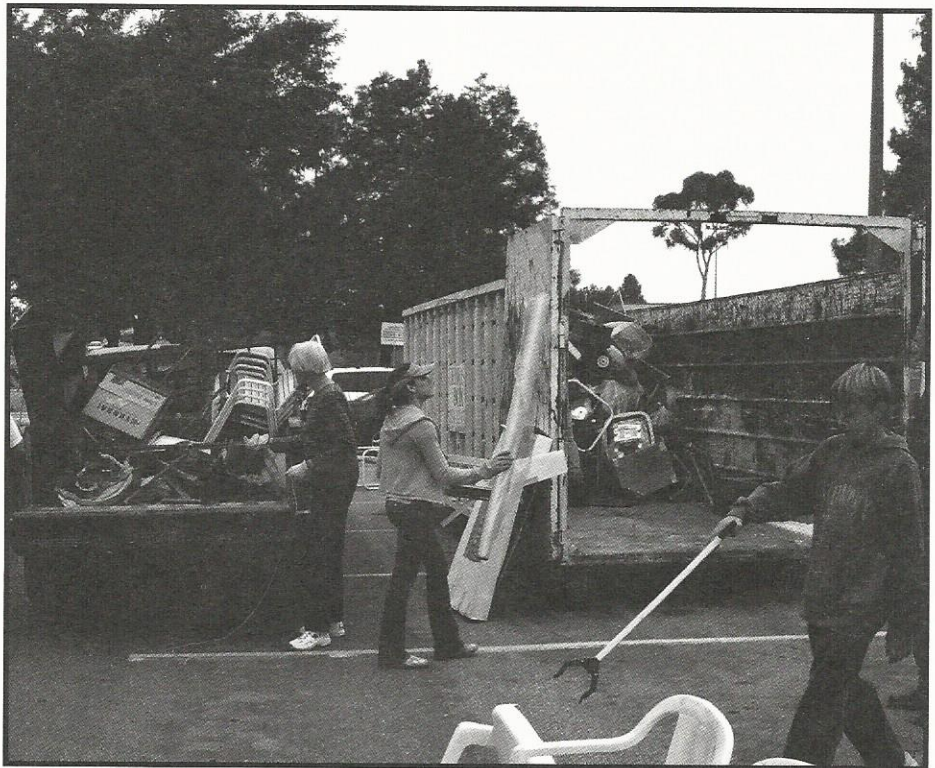

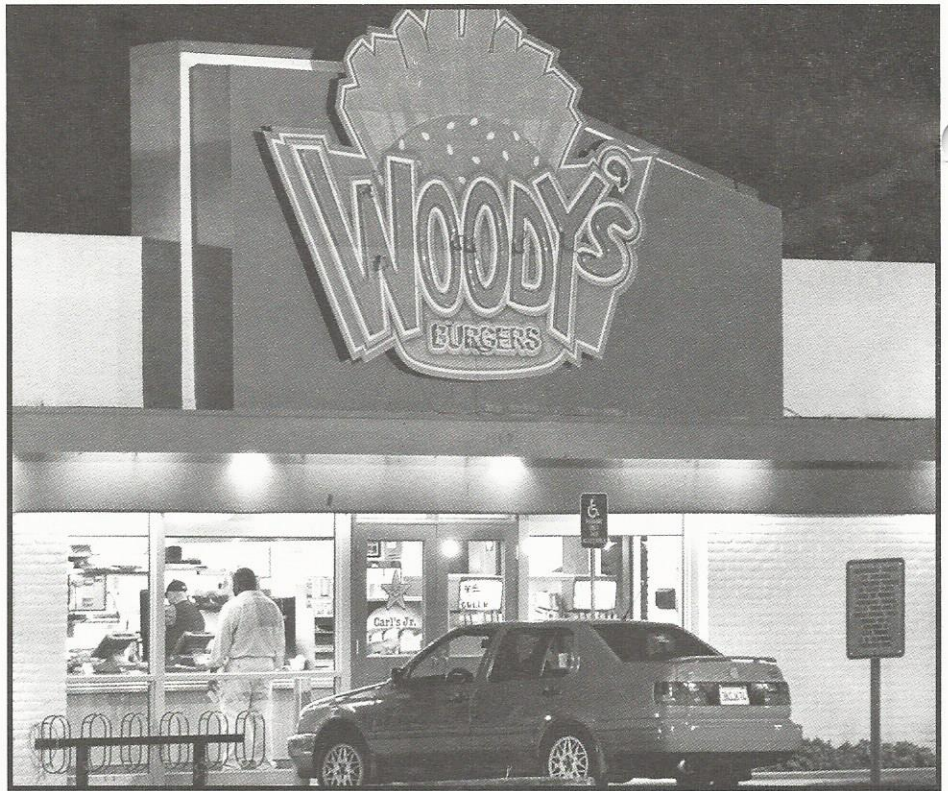

## Strategic Planning Committee Chooses Miramar

### Full Airport Authority Board to consider site at June 5<sup>th</sup> meeting

On May 22<sup>nd</sup>, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority's Strategic Planning Committee voted 3-1 to forward a motion choosing Miramar as the new airport site to the full Board for its consideration at its June 5<sup>th</sup> public meeting. The committee consists of four members of the full nine member Airport Authority Board. The committee members are Paul Nieto, Chair; Paul Peterson; Lemon Grove Mayor Mary Sessom; and San Diego City Councilmember Anthony Young. Sessom cast the dissenting vote.

The June 5<sup>th</sup> public meeting of the full Airport Authority Board is scheduled for 8a.m. at the Sheraton Harbor Island Hotel and Marina, West Tower, Fairbanks Ballroom, 1590 Harbor Island Dr.

The Airport Authority held a series of Community Conversations on final airport site selections analysis the week of May 22<sup>nd</sup>. A number of those in attendance at the May 22<sup>nd</sup> evening meeting at the Town and Country hotel expressed frustration with the process, meeting format, lack of meetings in communities most affected by

Miramar, the last minute notification of scheduled public meetings and apparent pre-determined selection of Miramar as the chosen site.

**Important dates:** The Board is expected to discuss the final airport site selection analysis at the Airport Authority Board Meeting at 8 a.m. on June 5<sup>th</sup>. A public comment period is part of this meeting. Final ballot measure language is due to the County Registrar of Voters on August 11<sup>th</sup>. State legislation calls for the Airport Authority to place an airport site selection measure on the ballot for a county-wide public vote. The county-wide election on the airport site selection ballot measure is November 7<sup>th</sup>.

## Did You Know?...

At press time, **SANDAG** (The San Diego Assn. of Governments) and **CalTrans** (The California Department of Transportation) were expected to announce plans for the expansion of state Route 52. Plans call for widening of westbound SR-52 from two to three lanes from Mast Blvd. to Santo Rd. The project is scheduled to start this fall as part of the roughly \$450 million **Transnet Early Action Project**. Widening of the eastbound lanes is slated to begin in 2007. The final section of SR-52 will extend east from SR-125 through Santee and connect with SR-67 with completion of the 4 lane stretch slated for 2010. Trans-net funded managed lanes between SR-125 and I-805 are also planned.

...As we went to press, we also awaited word regarding the release of the **EIR (Environmental Impact Report) for the seven alternatives in the UC North South Corridor Study (Regents Rd. Bridge, Genesee Widening, etc.)**. Word is the EIR will be released around mid-June. After a 30 day review period following its release, there will be a public hearing at which the City Council will choose an alternative. Information will be posted on [www.ucnorthsouth.com](http://www.ucnorthsouth.com) when the EIR is released...

...The **San Diego Airport Authority** was established by state law in 2003 to operate San Diego International Airport and address the region's long term air transportation needs. The Authority will choose a site for the airport on **June 5<sup>th</sup>**. There will be a **county-wide vote on November 7<sup>th</sup>**. See related article...
